

TIPS FOR FINDING FULL TEXT ARTICLES

From a computer on the UPHS Intranet OR from the Penn Presbyterian Medical Center Health Sciences Library

1. From the UPHS Intranet homepage click on the Biomedical Library (*The link is located under ON-LINE LIBRARIES at lower right side of the screen*)
2. Click on a Database (*Links to OVID MEDLINE, PubMed PLUS*, CINAHL/Nursing, ISI Web of Science, and All Health & Life Sciences Databases are listed on the left side of the screen.*)
**PubMed PLUS includes the full text articles to which the University of Pennsylvania subscribes*
3. Perform Search
4. Click on the Desired Citation
5. Click on "PENN TEXT" (*The location of "Penn Text" on the screen varies from one database to another*)

If the article is available on-line the following will display. A list of providers of the journal article appears.

Click on one of the links listed under Full Text and follow the instructions as given by the full text provider. (Sometimes you have to click through several screens to obtain the article. If you encounter a problem and are unable to obtain the full text ask the PMC Health Science Library Staff)
